

JUMPSTART 2021 Duty of Care

DSI is planning the JUMPSTART2021 (JS21) conference experience with attendee onsite safety and comfort as our top priority.

By attending JS21 in person, **you agree to abide by and engage in health and safety beneficial conduct such as the following:**

- On-site temperature checks and completion of health questionnaire before entering the event daily.
- Attendee materials will be individually bagged and available for pick up at the registration desk. Your materials bag will include a name badge/lanyard, personal hand sanitizer bottle, 3 individually packaged paper masks, a journal for notes and a pen.
- Mask wearing is required throughout the entire conference unless the attendee is actively involved in eating/drinking. You may bring your own mask.
- Social Distancing helps us help you to remain healthy. Attendees will be seated 6 ft apart in the ballroom. Signage will remind attendees of the 6 foot social distancing requirement. We ask that attendees please refrain from physical contact during the event (hugging, handshaking.)
- Refrain from attending if you are ill or have been recently exposed to COVID-19.

The Sheraton Wrigleyville is committed to facilitating a healthy environment onsite for all participants in terms of the conference and accommodations. (See Sheraton's Commitment to Clean— page 2 of this document.)

DSI continues to monitor the pandemic and Arizona guidelines for in person events. We have every intent of holding JS21 in person (with a virtual component for attendees unable to travel.) However, should the pandemic progress to the point that the Governor of Arizona place restrictions that would make the JS21 meeting impossible, DSI will move the entire meeting to a virtual format on the same dates/times.

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What Sheraton Wrigleyville associates are doing for the health and safety of all staff and guests:

- Following our “Commitment to Clean Plan” with training and guidelines.
- Practicing proper hand washing techniques and utilizing company provided hand sanitizer stations.
- Wearing facemasks.

Additional cleanliness practices that have been implemented in public/common areas:

- Property implemented guest-facing signage regarding changes in behaviors or social distancing.
- All public areas of the property being cleaned and disinfected based on the volume of use with the recommended disinfectants.
- All public restrooms being cleaned and disinfected based on the volume of use with the recommended disinfectants.
- We have relocated all credit card to the guest-facing side of the front desk, and we are disinfecting the equipment based on volume of use.
- We are disinfecting all used guestroom keys that are returned by guests or collected by associates before reusing them for another guest.
- We are taking steps to improve Air Quality, i.e. increasing outdoor air dilution and improving filtration.
- We are wiping down menus after each seating.
- We are disinfecting F&B furniture after every meal period and disinfecting tables and chairs between customers.
- Ensuring associates do not have barehand contact with ready to eat food for all food & beverage action stations, sanitizing food contact stations based on volume of use.
- Disinfecting food preparation tables every 2 hours, disinfecting nightly, and rinsing in the morning.
- Clean and disinfect registration, concierge, guest relations, business center, retail, lobby and elevator, handrails, tables, chairs, counters, buttons, entrances, water fountains, ATMs, hand sanitizing stations (contactless and pumps) areas based on volume of use with the recommended disinfectants.

Additional cleanliness practices that have been implemented in guest rooms:

- Stripping all used and unused linens and terry (e.g. duvet cover, top sheets, fitted sheets, flat sheets, pillowcases, towels, hand towels, wash cloths, bathmats) and removing them from the guest room prior to disinfection
- Removing all guestroom trash prior to disinfection.
- Performing routine housekeeping procedures, focusing on disinfection of all high touch hard surfaces.
- Disinfecting all unused/unopened nonrefillable bath amenities between guests.
- Removing and replacing all used and unused mugs/glassware/china/silverware for dishwashing.
- Disinfecting all high-touch hard surfaces, including: remote controls, light switches, door handles, telephone, etc.
